The Impact of the 26 November Earthquake in the Water Supply Networks, and the Responsiveness and Solidarity of the Water Sector



On the morning of November 26, 2019, Albania was hit by the strongest earthquake recorded in decades, of 6.4 magnitudes. Unfortunately, 51 lives were lost, over 1000 people were injured, and many buildings collapsed and have been severely damaged, mainly in the cities of Durres

and Thumane, as well as in other areas of Kruja, Tirana, Lezha and Kavaja.

The early hours after the earthquake were critical to saving lives under the buildings that had collapsed. The team from the Technical Department of Durres Water Supply and Sewerage Company (WSSC) was quick to respond to this emergency, by setting up a verification team to assist the search and rescue operation at the collapsed facilities. The operation was led by the engineering staff of Durres WSSC and it was carried out by the staff of the maintenance department, who did a heroic job, under very dangerous circumstances.

SHUKALB played a proactive role in offering its support to the most affected water companies mainly Durres WSSC and Kruja WSSC. read more

On 16 to 18 October 2019, in Tirana, the Global Water Partnership – Mediterranean organized the 3rd Regional Nexus Roundtable in South East Europe (SEE). The three day event was organized jointly with the German Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation and Nuclear Safety and supported by the German Federal Environment Agency, Global Environment Facility's (GEF) International Waters Learning Exchange and Resource Network, and Austrian Development Agency.

The 3rd Regional Nexus Roundtable followed up on the previous ones held in Belgrade in 2017 and in Skopje in 2018. The overall aim of these Roundtables is to assist towards achieving the Nexus-related objectives of the Dimension "Environment" of the SEE2020 Strategy, by facilitating dialogue processes in the South East Europe Region for the incorporation of Water-Energy-Food-Ecosystems Nexus considerations in national and transboundary water resources management planning.

This 3rd Roundtable mainly focused on enhancing related capacities, on assisting towards the identification and prioritization of Nexus-related solutions, and on discussing potential next steps at the regional level. <u>read more</u>
